2017 Pepper Varieties

The following is a list of the varieties of pepper plants we will be growing for you this year.

Sweet Bell Peppers

*Cute Stuff Red 62 day Green/red 3 x 2.5 in. fruit Petite apple-shaped bell is the perfect size for fresh eating, salads, and stuffing with crunchy flesh and a sweet, summery flavor.

*Early Summer 70-75 day Dark Green/Yellow 4-5 x 4-4.5 in. fruit Strong plants produce many high-quality, extra-large peppers that are firm and glossy with thick walls and uniform blocky shape.

*Lady Bell 71 day Green/red 4 x 3.5 in. fruit Good yields of sweet, 3-4 lobed, thick-walled fruit.

*Majestic Red 75-85 day Green/red 5-7 x 2.5-3 in. fruit Huge, smooth fruit have a thick wall and crunchy texture. Fruit are blocky, firm, and heavy for their size and set quickly to ensure a good yield.

*New Ace 70 day Green/red 4 x 3 in. fruit Early maturing plant produces heavy yields of sweet peppers. One of the best bell peppers for areas with short or cool summers, even Alaska!

*Orange Blaze 65-70 day Green/orange 3-4 x 1.5 in. fruit Gorgeous 2 to 3-lobed fruits that mature early and boast very sweet flavor.

*Pinot Noir 68 day Lilac/red 5 x 4 in. fruit Large, blocky fruits blush simultaneously to shades of citrus, berry, and cherry red. The thick-walled peppers are very sweet and firm. Widely adaptable plants set fruit from cool to hot, humid conditions.

*Red Knight 65-70 day Green/red 4.5 x 4.5 in. fruit Vigorous, early-maturing variety is widely adapted throughout the northeastern U.S. Large to extra-large, thick-walled fruits.

*Revolution 72 day Green/red 4.75 x 4.5 in. fruit Produces a concentrated set and good yields in cool weather. 4-lobed, blocky, thick walled.

Sweet Non-Bell Peppers:

*Sweet Banana 65-70 day Yellow/red 6 x 1.5 in. fruit Medium-thick walls. Banana type.

Chili Peppers:

*Alma Paprika 70-80 day White/red 1 x 2 in. fruit Popular Hungarian pickling type has thick, crunchy, medium-hot fruit that are mushroom-shaped.

*Cayenne Long Thin 70-75 day Green/red 4-6 x 0.75 in. fruit Very hot, tapered fruit with a twisted shape is thin-walled and two-celled.

*Serrano 85-90 day Bright green/red 1-2 x 0.5 in. fruit Dozens of medium-thin walled fruit.

*Super Chili 75 day Green/red 2.5 x 1.5 in. fruit Very productive, semi-compact plants produce upward-facing, cone-shaped chili peppers with a spicy flavor. Also good for ornamental use.

Anaheim Peppers:

*Anaheim 74-76 day Green/red 5 x 3 in. fruit Long, tapered fruit are flat, thick-walled and smooth. Mild pepper is good for roasting.

*Joe E Parker 70-90 day 8 x 1.8 in. fruit The flesh is crisp, thick, mild heat and has an excellent flavor. A great Southwestern type Anaheim Chili pepper. Plants are medium tall and very productive.

Ancho Peppers:

*Tiburon 65 day Dark green/red 5 x 1 in. fruit High yields of extra-large peppers on vigorous plants with good foliage cover. Mildly pungent flesh is sweeter than other Anchos. Good for roasting.

Habanero Peppers:

*Habanero Orange 95-100 day Light green/orange 1 x 1.5 in. fruit One of the hottest peppers available. Thin-walled fruit wrinkles at maturity.

Ethnic Hot Peppers:

*Hungarian Hot Wax 65-70 day Bright yellow/red 5 in. long fruit Makes a great pickled pepper!

Hungarian Yellow Wax 55-85 day Fruit changes from yellow to orange to red 5-8 x 1-2 in. fruit Medium-thick walls. Best hot pepper variety for cool climates.

*Salsa Garden 73 day Dark green/red 8-9 x 1 in. fruit Moderately hot, tapered fruit has medium-thick walls.

*Jalapeno 75-80 day Green/red 3 x 1.5 in. fruit Pungent, sweet-hot peppers deliver flavor and heat! Thick-walled fruits grow on vigorous plants.
